The brigade has been very quiet this month with fire calls. A few deployments to Gippsland and with the recent rain around the state, does not mean we can relax. We have had thunderstorms over the Brisbane Ranges the last weeks; with these comes lightning strikes. The ranges tend to attract lightning and the brigade worries when this weather happens. A strike could burn for hours and not be noticed. We would like community assistance in watching out for smoke. Call **TRIPLE ZERO (000)** if you notice anything. The CFA is going full steam ahead to prepare the community for bushfires. You need to be resilient over the next few months, as weather predictions

expect temperatures to heat up again. Minor works at the station have started and hopefully by the time you read this, they will be finished.

**Letter to the Editor**

Dear Editor,

In Windermere Ward north of Geelong, major fires occurred in 1969, 1985 and 2006. Those fires burnt through part of Lara where 23 people died, the You Yangs and in 2006 about one third of the Brisbane Ranges from Durdidwarrah to Anakie and back to Staughton Vale with a wind change. Ash and embers were falling at Corio Shopping Centre.

As there are plans for large scale residential developments at Lara West and Lovely Banks, there is a need for a long term fire mitigation plan for this area, with hotter and drier summers forecast.

For people in rural areas, silly council by-laws that restrict cleaning up fire hazards on properties should be scrapped.

Also, the roadway width of east-west roads and lanes needs to be wide enough for two trucks to meet and pass safely. Roadside vegetation needs to be cleared back to fence lines where possible to create a FIRE BREAK. This is so brigades have better access and water bombers a target line to drop retardant to slow down fires moving towards, for example, Corio. Fire fighters should be respected by improving road access and reducing fuel loads.

Long term locals who know the area should be listened to ahead of some newer residents who seem to prefer increasing fuel loads and creating roadside fire corridors.

The aftermath of a big fire is a costly mess to sort out. Hands-on, practical people put fires out, whereas university academics' theories and bureaucrats in city offices do not.

City of Greater Geelong councillors and officials need to be proactive on this issue and stop being brainwashed by Agenda 21 sustainability dictates and put saving people's lives and property first.

Also, in the Windermere Ward area in dry times there is an increased pollution overlay on vegetation from Avalon Airport flights and sea breezes that move city pollution inland. This causes vegetation to burn more rapidly. Unless we get wetter periods, this will be an ongoing problem with fire intensity.

How does increasing fuel loads and restricting road access save wildlife and biodiversity in big fires? Preventing and putting out big fires should be the focus.



Health News & More ...

Eye Health: What price are your eyes? That seems like a strange question ... priceless of course! But so many people *do not* have regular eye checks.

So how often should you have them checked? Every two years is satisfactory providing you have no underlying problems that may cause damage to your eyes, e.g. Diabetes, in which case an annual check-up may be advised by your Optometrist.

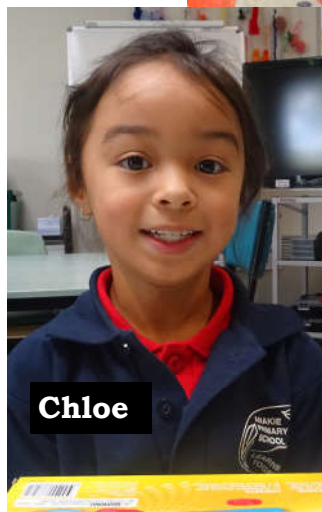
