Little Roos Celebrate a Memorable First Season



The 2026 football season has been one to remember for the Form'N Earth Under 10s at Anakie Football Club, with 16 young players taking to the field for their very first season.

Led by fearless coach Phil Millar and supported by team sponsors Jake Forman, Glenn Giacometti, Scott Forman and Glen Taylor, the team quickly developed their football skills while building confidence, teamwork and strong friendships.

A dedicated group of family and friends were also there every week, providing sideline support, umpiring and plenty of essential match-day fuel, including party pies, Milo, milk and jelly snakes.

Across 16 weeks, the little Roos played nine home games and travelled 424 kilometres for six away matches. The season produced 74 goals, 80 points, almost 800 party pies, four kilograms of Milo and 32 bags of jelly snakes.

For first-time team manager Holly Millar, the season was about far more than the numbers. "I'm unbelievably grateful to have been part of such a positive experience with a bunch of kids who showed up with great spirit, and became my very first footy team family." Millar said. The 2026 Under 10s can now look back on a season filled with new skills, plenty of fun and memories to carry into 2027.

Anakie Fire Brigade News

Spring is here, and the change of season is a great time to check your smoke alarms.



Did you know that the smell of smoke alone will not wake you if you are asleep? Working, interconnected alarms in all bedrooms and living areas give you and your family the early warning needed to get out safely.

Checking yours takes a few minutes. Press the test button monthly, not just once a year. Give the alarm a clean with a vacuum brush, as dust and insects are a common cause of false alarms, and change the battery once a year; a good tip is to Sharpie the replacement date onto the battery. Lastly, look for the date printed on the back. Smoke alarms don't last forever, and anything over 10 years old should be replaced entirely. You can learn more at **cfa.vic.gov.au/smokealarms**

Warmer weather also means barbecue season. Before you cook, check the gas hoses and connections for cracks and test for leaks with soapy water, and clean the fat out of the grill and drip tray. Keep the barbecue well clear of fences and overhanging branches, and turn the gas off at the bottle when you're finished. For more BBQ safety tips, visit **www.cfa.vic.gov.au/bbq**

Finally, a reminder about the 40km/h rule.

When you pass a stationary or slow-moving emergency vehicle displaying flashing red, blue, magenta or yellow lights, or sounding an alarm, you must slow to 40km/h.



This applies on every road, including multi-lane roads and highways. It includes fire trucks, ambulances and police, tow trucks and roadside assistance vehicles. Unless there is a median strip between you and the scene, it applies to traffic in both directions.

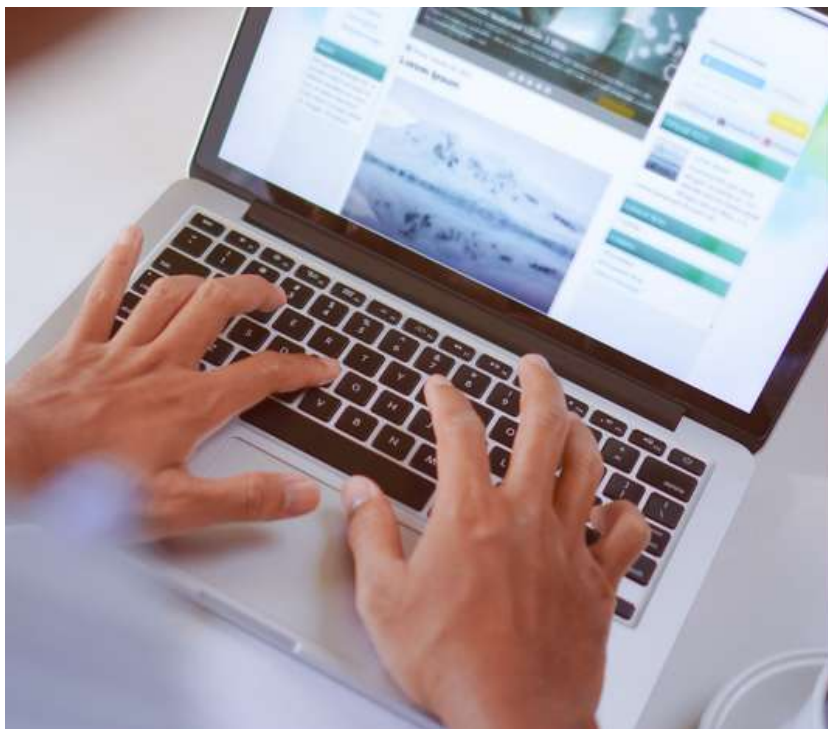

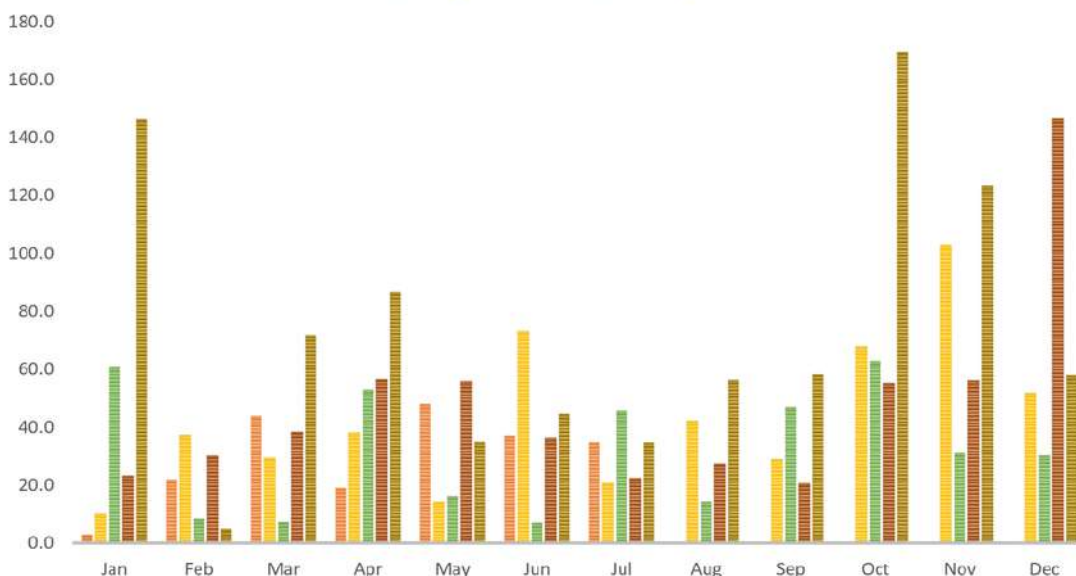

WHAT TO PLANT IN SEPTEMBER

The Brisbane Ranges are putting on their magical spring wildflower display, with the wattles bursting into bloom as the most visible sign that spring is on its way. The days are slowly getting longer and a little warmer, and it's time to get the veggie garden ready for the season ahead. Get leeks, onions, peas, radish, silverbeet, lettuce and brassicas like cauliflower in the ground, plus herbs such as chamomile, dill, coriander and thyme. Hold off on tomatoes and other summer crops until the last frost passes, but feel free to start them indoors now for a head start. Lay down some mulch too, as the weeds are just as keen for spring as your veggies are.

Dandelion: a genus of flowering plants in the family Asteraceae.

Dandelions grow around the world but are absent in tropical and polar areas. They are generally good for you because they are packed with vitamins A, C, and K, as well as fibre, iron, and potassium. However they should not be picked for food in areas known to be treated with chemicals. All parts of the plant are edible: the leaves can be eaten raw in salads, the flowers can also be added to salads for colour, the buds can be pickled (like capers) and the roots can be dried, roasted and ground into powder and used to make a coffee substitute. Dandelions contain anti-oxidants and are useful to support normal blood sugar levels; they are also an excellent liver tonic.



Remember: always seek medical advice if you take prescription medications or suffer with chronic health conditions prior to taking any plant or herbal medicines.
