National AusAlert Test

On Monday, 27 July 2026 at 2:00 pm, a National AusAlert test will be sent to all compatible mobile devices, including phones, smart watches, and tablets.

Your device will vibrate and play a siren sound for 10 seconds, and a message will appear on your screen clearly stating it is a test. You do not need to take any action upon receiving the alert. If receiving this siren sound would cause you or a family member to feel unsafe, please switch your mobile devices to 'airplane mode' or turn them off for at least one hour during the scheduled test time. Winter Fire Safety

During these colder months, it is tempting to plug multiple appliances into a single power board to stay warm. Please avoid "piggybacking" appliances, as this can cause boards to overheat and potentially start an electrical fire. Whenever possible, plug high-load heating equipment directly into a wall outlet. As well as another reminder to take two minutes this month to press the test button on your smoke alarms. It is the simplest and most effective way to ensure your family is protected, and we recommend making this a monthly habit.

Stay warm and safe throughout the winter season.

What does an AusAlert look like?

Depending on your device type and operating system, an AusAlert message will look something like this:



The AusAlert messages shown on screen are examples only and not real AusAlerts.

What does an AusAlert sound like?

A **Critical Alert** will cause your mobile device to vibrate and will be delivered with a loud siren-like warning sound that lasts about 10 seconds. It will make this noise even if you've set your device to 'silent' or 'do not disturb' mode.

A **Priority Alert** may vibrate and include a siren-like warning sound, but exactly how it is delivered will depend on your settings, device type and operating system.

Is an AusAlert a text message?

No, an AusAlert isn't an SMS or text message – it's an 'alert'. It will appear as a notification on your mobile device's screen and will show up during phone calls, app use, and on lock screens. You'll need to close the notification once you've seen the message, otherwise it will remain on your screen.

What do I do if I receive an AusAlert?

You should read and understand the AusAlert and follow the instructions to keep yourself and others safe.

Should I wait until I receive an AusAlert to act in an emergency?

It's important you don't wait to receive an AusAlert before acting in a disaster. You must still prepare yourself, have an action plan and be proactive. AusAlert is just one way to stay safe. Turn on local or national TV or radio, check emergency services apps, or search online for more information about the emergency.

Will my mobile be able to receive an AusAlert?

Mobile devices such as compatible mobile phones and some tablets and smart watches will be able to receive an AusAlert message. AusAlerts are expected to work on iPhones 11 and up running iOS 16.4 or later and Android phones and tablets running Android 12 or later. Always install the latest software updates on your device when asked so you're ready to receive AusAlerts.

What if I don't want to receive an AusAlert?

AusAlerts contain important information and should be turned on to help keep you safe. You can't opt out of a Critical Alert. The only way to not receive a Critical Alert is to turn your mobile device off or switch it to aeroplane mode. You can opt out of an AusAlert Priority Alert. For more information, visit ausalert.gov.au

What if I receive an AusAlert while driving?

If you receive an AusAlert while driving or riding, stay calm and don't touch your phone. Mobile phone laws remain active – don't read or respond to the alert while moving. The AusAlert may make a siren-like sound for about 10 seconds. Only check the message when it is safe and legal to do so.

20% off your car rego

In the last edition I mentioned State Labor Government's registration rebates, which offer you a 20% rebate off the cost of your 2025/2026 car registration costs. I wanted to reach out with some further information on how you can apply for this rebate.

Rebates are available for up to two personal vehicles under 4.5 tonnes per person, for registrations paid between 1 July 2025 and 30 June 2026. To apply you need to have your licence number, car registration and bank details.

You can make the application via the Service Victoria app or visit the website **service.vic.gov.au/regorebate**

Jerusalem Artichoke: (*Helianthus tuberosus*) is a herbaceous perennial plant growing to 1.5–3 m tall; the leaves have a rough, hairy texture. It is a species of sunflower native to central North America. It is cultivated for its tuber, which is used as a root vegetable; it can be eaten raw, cooked, or pickled.

Unlike most tubers, but in common with many other members of the Asteraceae family, (including the artichoke), Jerusalem Artichoke tubers store their carbohydrate as inulin rather than as starch. This has made them an important source of inulin which is used as a reliable source of fibre in food manufacturing. Jerusalem Artichokes contain 650 mg potassium per 150 g serving. They are also high in iron and contain 10–12% of the recommended daily fibre, niacin, thiamine, phosphorus, and copper.

Serrated Tussock on our roadsides

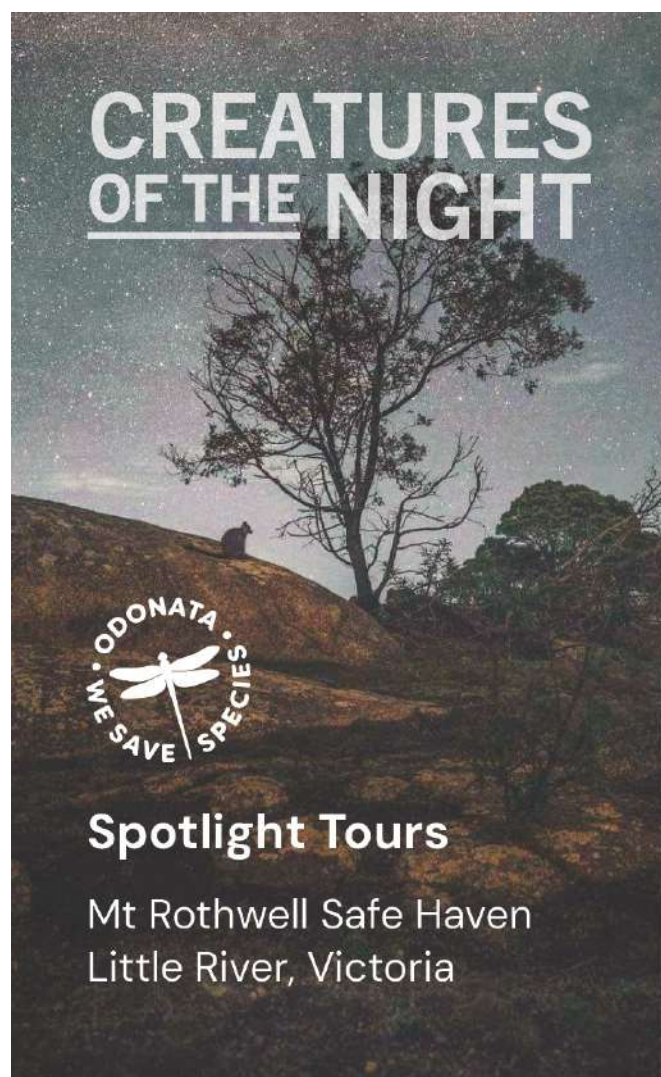
The City of Greater Geelong get their roadside weed contractors to record where the weeds are and map how intense the infestation is. The map opposite illustrates the situation for Serrated Tussock (ST) in our district.

The problem with this map is that it doesn't illustrate the level of ST infestation in the adjoining private land. The City of Greater Geelong spend \$100K per year to eradicate ST, but if the adjoining land is full of the weed, then the 100,000 seeds per plant will just keep on blowing in and their efforts will be somewhat futile.

Please control serrated tussock if it is present on your property.

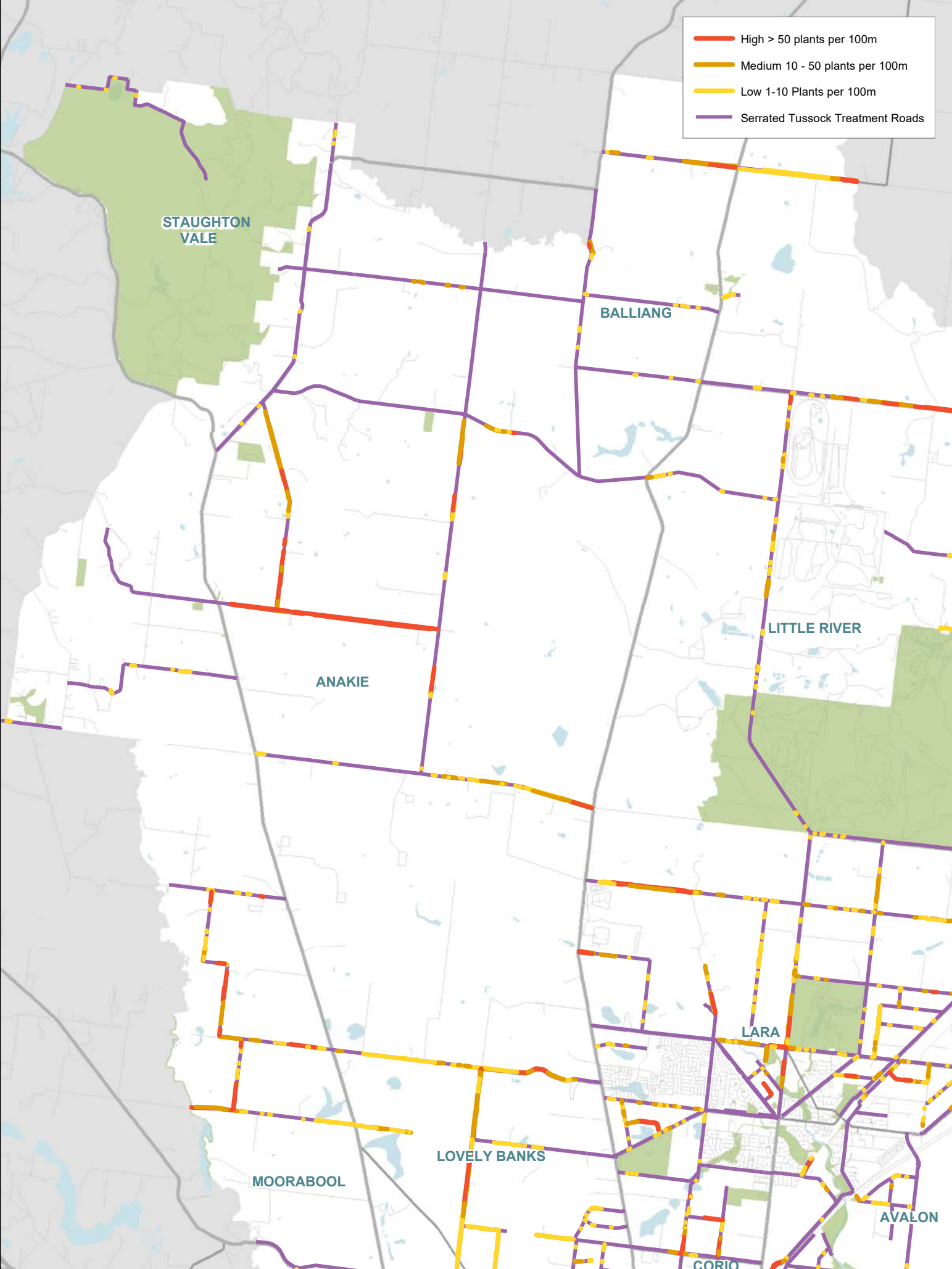
