Fire Danger Period Has Ended

The Fire Danger Period for Greater Geelong, Moorabool, and Golden Plains Shires has officially ended bringing our summer season to an end. Thank you to the entire Anakie community for your incredible support over the busy summer months.



Even though the season is over, if you are planning a burn-off to clear your property, please register it. Registering your burn prevents us from being paged to a "false alarm." **You can register your activity online at firepermits.vic.gov.au or by calling 1800 668 511 (Open 24 Hours)**

Have you checked your smoke alarms?

If you didn't get a chance to check your smoke alarms when the clocks changed last month, now's the perfect time to check them as we come into the colder weather. Its recommended you check your smoke alarm every month.

"One Metre" Rule

Now is also the time when many of us bring heaters out of storage. Please remember the "One metre" rule: keep all clothes, curtains, and furniture at least one metre away from any heat source. There has also been a rise in dryer fires around the state, So if you use a clothes dryer, ensure you clean the lint filter after every single load, as a build-up of lint is a common cause of household fires in winter.

Home Escape Plan

It is also vital that you have a Home Escape Plan. In a fire, you may have as little as two minutes to escape safely. Ensure everyone in your household knows at least two ways out of every room and has a designated meeting place outside. **You can get helpful tips and a planning template at www.cfa.vic.gov.au/escape-plans**

Cultivating Community

Anakie Garden Project Receives Funding

We are delighted to announce that Anakie Community House has received a Community Investment Program Grant from Community Bank Lara District to support the next phase of our garden project. We are very grateful for this funding which will allow us to install new picnic tables, seating, and a community BBQ, creating a welcoming outdoor space for workshops, gatherings, and social connection.

Following the successful completion of Phase 1—funded through the Victorian State Government’s Tiny Towns program—which delivered new landscaping and drought-tolerant native plantings, we are now developing a community edible garden.

The garden will include wicking beds, a potting table, and a greenhouse (generously donated by Warralily Community Garden), providing opportunities for people to learn gardening skills, grow fresh produce, and connect with others. These additions will help create a vibrant, inclusive community space that promotes sustainability, wellbeing, and social connection.

Cost of Living Supports

In the last edition, I shared some information on different cost of living supports that are available. In addition, the State Labor Government recently announced that we will be introducing a Midday Power Saver starting from 1 October 2026, to help households save money by switching their power use to the middle of the day.



The Midday Power Saver is a regulated tariff that energy retailers will be required to offer to eligible customers. Retailers are required to provide free power for a period during the middle of the day. For those who sign up to the offer and switch their power usage to the middle of the day, it is anticipated that they could save between \$100 to \$1,070 per year on their energy bills.

If you are a customer who can shift a lot of your power use to the middle of the day it could help you lower your energy bills.

FROM THE MAYOR'S DESK

MAY 2026

Golden Plains Shire is growing – and growing fast. With the upcoming 2026 State Election, this is the time to advocate for increased infrastructure, services and community facilities.

Our towns continue to attract families, businesses and investment. While this is fantastic, we need to ensure we meet the demands of our growing communities.

That's why we've identified a focused set of priority areas that are critical to supporting our community now and into the future.

With a predicted population forecast of over 42,000 by 2041, we need investment into a community where people can thrive.

These priorities are evidence based, community informed and address issues felt right across the community – such as public transport, road safety and digital connectivity.

We know the lack of public transport across the Shire greatly affects our community, which is why we're calling for increased public bus and transport

services and reinstating the passenger rail from Bannockburn to Geelong.

These actions are essential to support workforce participation, access to education and health services and reduce car dependency.

We also need road safety to support these ambitions – road upgrades to McPhillips Road in Bannockburn and Russell's Bridge Road in Russells Bridge are great starting points.

The Midland Highway is also an essential corridor between Ballarat and Geelong and duplicating that stretch of road would support the heavy traffic we're seeing on the road daily.

We have an active community who enjoy the outdoors – we want to see tracks and trails and off-road links that will improve connectivity between townships.

The Bannockburn–Teesdale offroad link, the Ross Creek and Smythesdale trails, and similar routes across the municipality reflect the trail network our community is calling for.

When residents raise these proposals through consultation, we want to meet that demand and turn those ideas into real, accessible trails.

Community safety is a top priority, which is why we need an Ambulance Victoria station in Smythesdale.

People in Smythesdale and surrounding towns are having to wait for Ambulances from Ballarat, and that's just not good enough. This is fundamental to improving response times.

Golden Plains Shire has one of the lowest Code 1 ambulance response times performances in Victoria. With the rate at which our municipality is growing, we need to increase emergency services everywhere.

Young people are the heart of our community, and with the population of children and young people growing rapidly, we need new Kindergartens in Inverleigh, Lethbridge and Bannockburn, and upgrades to the Kinder at Woody Yaloak.

With this, we also need to ensure there's plenty of spaces for play and social connection.

That's why we want to upgrade Teesdale Turtle Bend Reserve, the Lethbridge playground, construct the Moorabool River Playspace in Batesford and Smythesdale Sub-Regional Play Space.

Other priorities include sewerage infrastructure for Meredith, scrapping the Emergency Services and Volunteers Fund, and improving mobile and digital connectivity across the Shire.

There's lots to do – which is why myself, fellow Councillors and the CEO are continuing to meet with key delegates and representatives to advocate for these essential projects.

We recently met with Peri Urban Council's Victoria to discuss election priorities across the Peri Urban group and how we can work together to deliver a balanced set of priorities that benefit us and surrounding regions.

This advocacy is not about politics. It is about partnership.

We hope the governments take our priorities seriously and are willing to invest in the future of Golden Plains Shire.

Only with continued investment can we secure the Shire's future as a vibrant, welcoming place to live, work and raise a family.

WHAT TO PLANT IN MAY

Autumn is the quiet achiever of the gardening calendar — and May is prime planting time - perfect conditions for leafy greens, root vegetables, and hearty brassicas to establish before winter. A little effort now means plenty on the table come July and August.



VEGETABLES

Discover the best cool-season vegetables to grow in May for winter harvest. Broad beans, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, kale, leek, lettuce, peas, radish, silverbeet, spinach, English spinach, turnip, garlic, onion, potato (Kipfler or Dutch Cream)

HERBS

Enhance your garden with these essential herbs that thrive in cooler weather - Chives, coriander, dill, mint, parsley, rosemary, thyme, chamomile

TIPS

Plant peas and beans near your brassicas, they fix nitrogen in the soil, giving your broccoli, cabbage, and kale a free feed all winter.

Autumn leaves are garden gold. Add them to your compost bin now and by spring you'll have rich, crumbly compost ready to dig through your beds.
