Anakie Fire Brigade News

Happy June! The cold weather has truly arrived.



With mornings becoming increasingly foggy and our daylight hours shortening as we head deeper into the season, now is the time to prioritize safety at home and on the road.

Stay Safe on Foggy Roads

With the return of chilly, foggy mornings, road conditions could deteriorate rapidly. Drive to the conditions and remember to turn on your low-beam headlights &/or fog lights to ensure you are visible to others. Avoid using high beams and increase your following distance to allow yourself time to react to hazards. If visibility becomes too poor to drive safely, find a spot well away from traffic to pull over, turn on your hazard lights, and wait for conditions to improve.

Stay Fire-Safe with Your Heater

As the temp drops and we begin using heating, the risk of structure fires increases. Maintain the "one meter" rule by keeping flammable items like curtains, clothing, and bedding at least one meter away from heaters and fireplaces. Never leave heaters or fireplaces unattended and ensure they are turned off before you leave a room or go to sleep.

Be Prepared for Storms and Floods

Storms and heavy rain can arrive with little warning, and VICSES is the agency for these events; you should call **132 500** for assistance during a storm or flood.

If a storm is approaching, stay indoors away from windows and avoid using electrical appliances. Most importantly, never drive through floodwater, as it is often deeper than it appears, and it may hide debris or damaged road surfaces. Monitor the Vic Emergency website, the app, or your local ABC radio station for the latest updates.

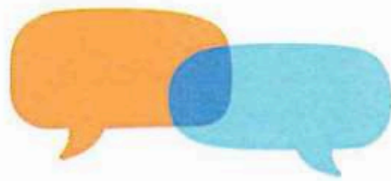
St Brigid's Church Farewell

How the State Government is helping with the cost of living

Cost of living pressures are being felt by everyone in our community. Here's an update on how the State Government is helping Victorians save money.

20% off your car rego

From 1 June 2026, you can apply for 20% off your car rego.

For most people in our region, who pay the outer metropolitan registration rate, that means saving of up to \$174 for one car, or \$348 for two.

If you have a concession, it will be 20% off your concession rate.

The rebate is for light vehicles – including cars, motorcycles, utes, vans, light trucks, station wagons, and 4WD wagons. You can apply for two vehicles per person. You can get your 20% off through the Service Victoria app. There'll be information on how to apply on the app from 1 June, but please contact my office if you have any questions. We're always happy to help out.

And make sure you get in quick – applications close 31 July 2026.

Saving on energy bills

As we head into winter, it's always good to check you're getting the best deal on your energy, or think about upgrading your home to be more energy efficient.

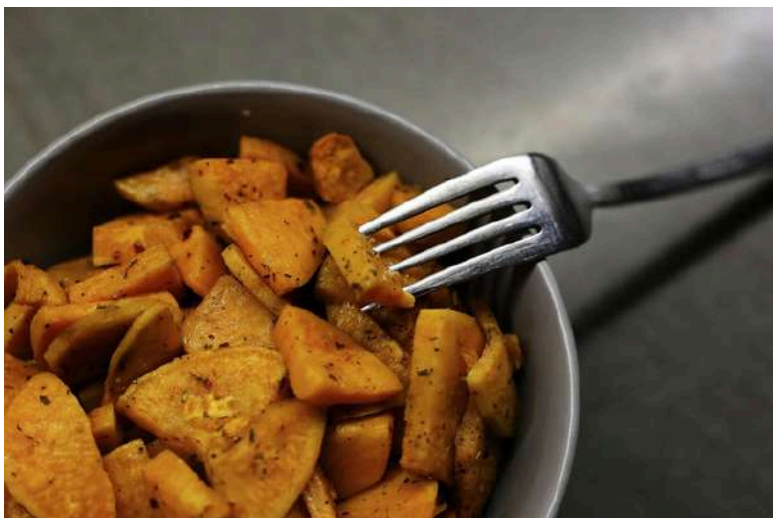

Yacon: (*Polymnia sonchifolia*) also called 'Apple of the Earth", is an edible tuber, low in calories, making it ideal for diabetics. It is easy to grow: in full sun with well-rotted compost. The sweet, crunchy roots or tubers are harvested in late autumn after the leaves have dried and shrivelled. If left to dry for a few days the tubers increase in sweetness. Peel then steam or use in stir-fries. Yacon can also be eaten raw and used in salads..

WHAT TO PLANT IN JUNE

Now that winter is here with shorter, cooler days, the garden awaits cold-tolerant greens and crops that don't mind a frost or two. Plant patiently now and you'll have leeks, broad beans, and fresh greens carrying you right through to spring.



VEGETABLES

Cold-hardy crops to tuck into the garden now for late winter and spring harvests - Broad beans, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, English spinach, kale, leek, lettuce, mustard greens, onion, peas, silverbeet, shallots, garlic, asparagus crowns, rhubarb crowns.



HERBS

Tough little workhorses that won't mind the frost - chives, garlic chives, mint, parsley, rosemary, sage, thyme, oregano, sorrel and lemon balm. Most will sit happily through the cold and reward you with fresh flavour right when the kitchen needs it most.



TIPS

Mulch your garden beds thickly. It insulates roots from frost, keeps moisture in, and breaks down to feed the soil come spring.

Winter is bare-rooted season - fruit trees, roses, and berries are sold dormant and ready to plant. They're cheaper than potted versions and establish faster.

A koala monitoring project beside the Moorabool River has revealed a surprising rise in koala activity only one year after large-scale tree planting efforts began.

The Koala Clancy Foundation and International Fund for Animal Welfare planted more than 11,300 trees and shrubs at the site in 2023 and 2024. Audio recorders were then used each November to monitor koala calls during breeding season.

In the first year, researchers recorded only four koala calls, which was expected because the new habitat was still developing. However, in the second year, koala calls tripled, indicating a rapid increase in koala use of the area. Recordings captured several male koalas and even evidence of mating.

Koala Clancy Foundation's Janine Duffy said the team was surprised by how quickly koalas responded to the restored habitat. IFAW's Josey Sharrad said the results show how urgently koalas need safe habitat and demonstrate that habitat restoration can quickly benefit wildlife.

The project is being celebrated as proof that revegetation efforts can successfully support koala recovery and provide hope for the species' future.

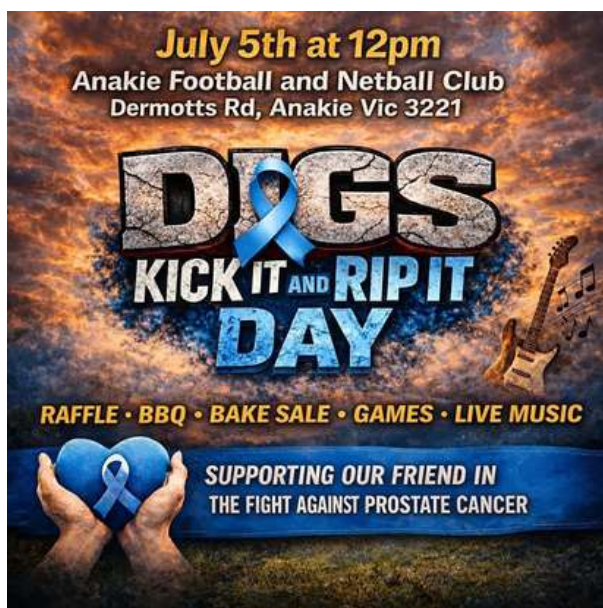
