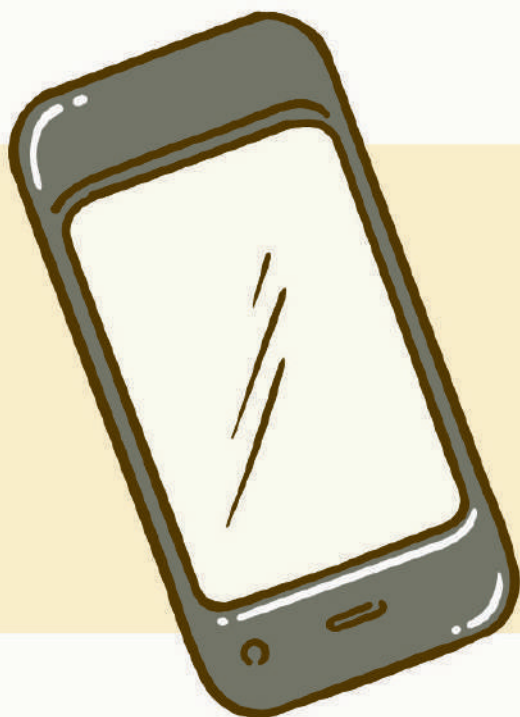

Good news for the Brisbane Ranges and Steiglitz

- *continued from Page 1*

In June, I met with residents from Lara, Anakie and Steiglitz who were worried about the potential for mining and resource extraction in the two parks. We gathered in Steiglitz, once a bustling gold mining town in the 1860s. The historic park there holds an important piece of Victoria's gold story, and the surrounding Brisbane Ranges are one of the most beautiful corners of our region. They're well known for their native wildflowers, including species that have become rare or extinct elsewhere.

An exploration licence has covered part of this area for a long time and understandably, that worried people who live nearby and love this landscape. I took those concerns to the Minister for Resources and worked on this alongside Michaela Settle MP, the Member for Eureka, to secure this outcome.

Elsewhere in the licence area, strict controls still apply. Any exploration has to stay inside the approved licence area and meet environmental and safety requirements, with all necessary consents in place before work begins. Resources Victoria authorised offices will be keeping a close watch on that.

I want to thank the locals and the Friends of Brisbane Ranges who work so hard to look after this landscape.

I'm really proud that together, we achieved this great outcome to ban mining and mining exploration in Steiglitz Historic Park. If you have any questions about this, please get in touch. I'm always happy to have a chat about how we can better protect our beautiful environment.

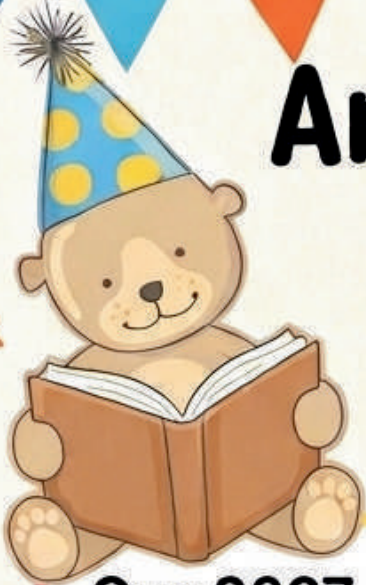

Proposed Community Development

Some members of the Staughton Vale and Anakie communities recently became aware of a new permit application by Bacchus Marsh Grammar. The application seeks to discard the current permit and apply for a new Ministerial Permit (PA2604229) to change the use of the 155 Staughton Vale Road campus from an Agricultural School to an Education Centre. The notification period began on Thursday 9 July, with formal objections due by 28 July. This meant there was little time to inform residents who were unaware of the application before the objection deadline. However, it is not too late to get involved. We strongly encourage everyone to review as much information as possible and make their own judgement.

Our main concerns include the lack of communication, transparency and information, as well as bushfire, wildfire and traffic issues.

We are not opposed to the Agricultural Centre or to schools using this area to give children experiences beyond their usual backyards. As rural residents, we welcome city children coming here to enjoy our fresh air and beautiful natural habitats, but not at the expense of our own homes and towns.

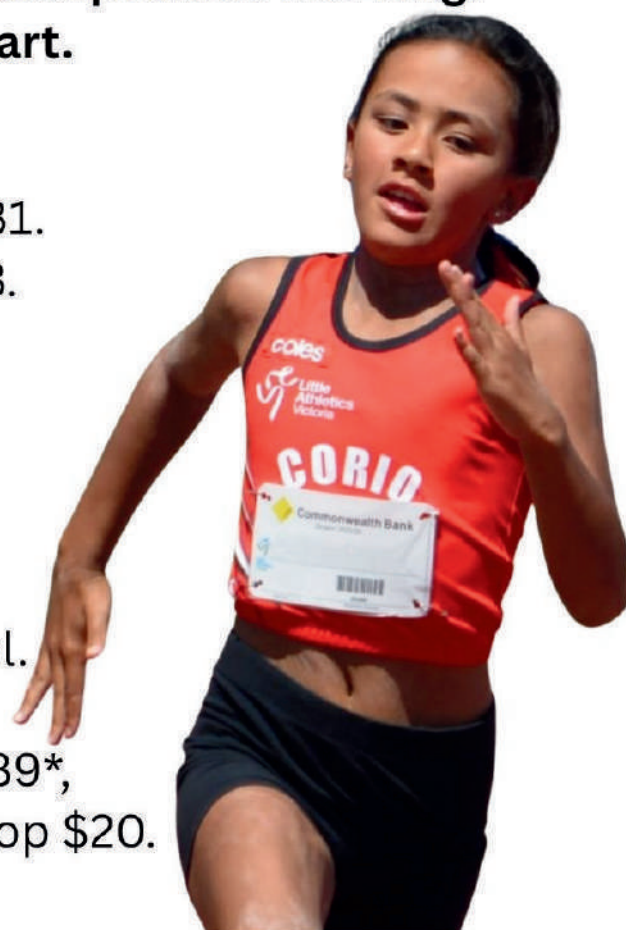

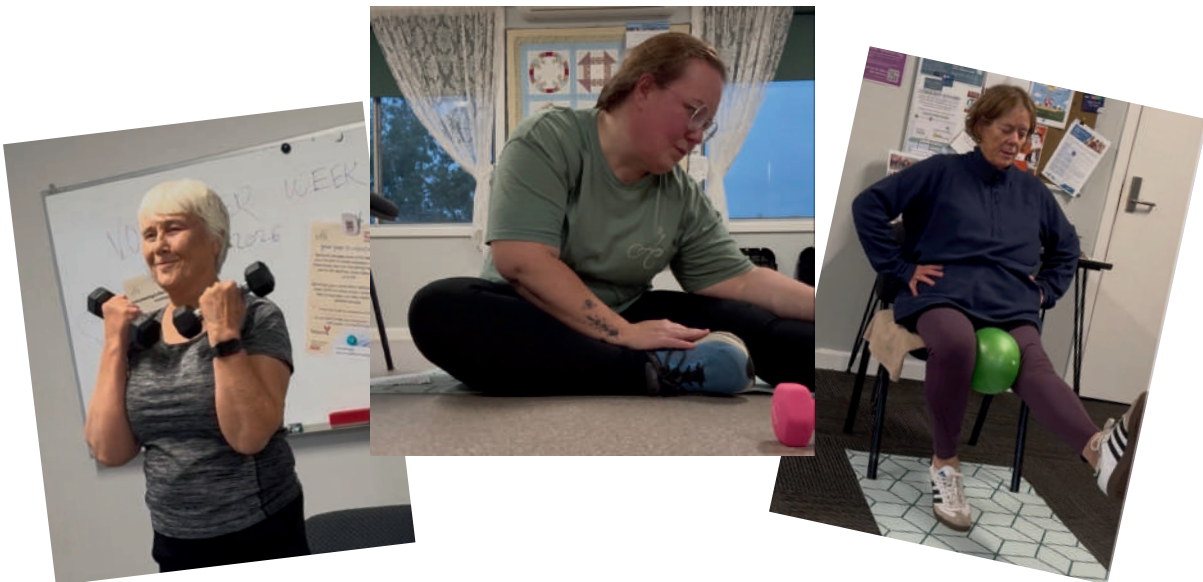

WHAT TO PLANT IN AUGUST

The days are getting longer and the soil is slowly warming. It's the perfect time to get ahead of spring by planting fast-growing crops and preparing beds for the busy season ahead. A little work now and your garden will burst into life come September.



VEGETABLES

Beetroot, broad beans (last chance), broccoli, cabbage, cauliflower, kale, leek, lettuce, onion, peas, potato, radish, shallots, silverbeet, spinach, spring onions, Asian greens, bok choy, kohlrabi.



HERBS

Chives, coriander, dill, mint, parsley, rosemary, thyme, oregano, lemongrass



TIPS

Bare-rooted season — plant fruit trees, roses and berry canes.

Boost soil with compost and manure before spring planting.

Watch for slugs and snails — beer traps work well.

Feed citrus trees with specialised fertiliser this month.

Silverbeet: or 'Chard', like many other green leafy vegetables, has highly nutritious leaves and stems; it has been used in cooking for centuries. Silverbeet is often overlooked in favour of spinach, but it is far more versatile and much easier to grow. Indeed, if left to go to seed during summer, it will happily drop its seeds and regrow for the following season. Silverbeet is high in fibre, rich in vitamins A, K and C. It also contains significant amounts of magnesium, manganese, iron and potassium but is low in calories, carbohydrates and fat.



Caution: Silverbeet has a very high oxalate content, one of the highest among edible vegetables. If you have kidney stones or take blood thinning medication you may need to avoid or minimise this vegetable in your diet. As always, consult your GP for the best advice on this matter.

Winter Warming Recipe- Tuna Pasta Bake

Ingredients:

- 425g Tuna in spring water - drained
- 1 cup of pasta - spiral, penne or macaroni
- 1 cup of chopped veggies - whatever is in season, or frozen peas, corn, carrot
- 2 tablespoons of butter
- 1/4 cup of plain flour
- 1 cup of milk
- 1 cup of grated cheese
- Herbs of your choice if desired
- 1/2 cup of breadcrumbs



Method:

- Preheat oven to 180 degrees
- In a saucepan of boiling water, add pasta and vegetables until cooked through (roughly 10 minutes) - drain and set aside
- In the same saucepan, melt the butter then add the flour - stir to combine (should be very thick. Add more flour if not)
- Take off the heat and slowly add the milk while stirring
- Put back on low heat and stir until thickened (add more milk if needed)
- Add grated cheese and stir until smooth
- In a large bowl, mix pasta and veggies, tuna, herbs and cheese sauce
- Add salt and pepper to taste
- Pour into a baking/lasagne dish
- Mix breadcrumbs with a little olive oil to get a clumpy texture and sprinkle over the top
- Bake until breadcrumbs are nicely browned - roughly 20 minutes
