November in the Garden

Time to Get Growing

November is one of the best months for gardening in Anakie. The soil is warming up, the days are longer, and plants are ready to thrive. It's a great time to plant herbs like dill, chamomile, parsley, oregano, rosemary, thyme, and sage. Keep mint and lemon balm in pots, though — they'll quickly take over if planted in the ground.

For a productive patch, sow or plant capsicum, chilli, beetroot, carrots, cucumber, eggplant, lettuce, potatoes, pumpkins, leeks, silverbeet, squash, sweet corn, and zucchini.

Add some colour to your garden with chamomile, petunias, snapdragons, or marigolds. They'll brighten your space and attract pollinators and other helpful insects.

With the final month of spring here and temperatures soaring, the weather is certainly heating up!

First and foremost, I'd like to give a massive thank you to everyone who came along to our recent Open Day and Fire Planning Workshop. It was great to see so many community members engaging with our brigade and taking steps to prepare for the fire season.

As the Fire Danger Period gets closer, knowing where to get reliable, timely information is critical. You must have a plan, and a critical part of that plan is knowing how to stay informed. For real-time emergency information, make sure you know how to access the official warnings and advice. Find the most up-to-date info at these sources:

Official Emergency Information Sources

- VicEmergency Website & App: The key source for all warnings is the VicEmergency website (www.emergency.vic.gov.au). Download the VicEmergency App on your mobile device for alerts.
- VicEmergency Hotline: Call 1800 226 226 for information. Language assistance is available: use the National Relay Service on 1800 555 677 (for hearing/speech impairment).
- Radio & TV: Tune into ABC Local Radio (ABC Melbourne 594 AM and 774 AM), commercial and designated community radio stations (Bay 93.9 FM & K-Rock 95.5 FM), and Sky News TV.
- Social Media: Follow the official channels on Twitter (@CFA_Updates or @VicEmergency) and Facebook (facebook.com/cfavic or facebook.com/vicemergency).

Remember, emergency situations can change quickly, and power or mobile phone towers can fail.

Stay safe, stay informed, and enjoy the start of the warm weather!

Better Roads Blitz

The Labor Government is fixing roads across the Geelong region.

The massive Better Roads Blitz will sweep across the state, rebuilding, repairing and resurfacing roads across every corner of the state.

Backed by a record \$976 million investment, crews will be hard at work delivering hundreds of major maintenance projects on Victoria's roads – with 70 per cent of the funding dedicated to repairing regional roads.

This will include road resurfacing at Geelong-Ballan Road, Anakie; Geelong-Bacchus Marsh Road, Little River; and Midland Highway, Batesford along with rehabilitation works at Princes Highway West, between Anakie Road and Geelong-Bacchus Marsh Road at Corio.

These will be some of the many roads in the Geelong region undergoing works between now and mid-2026.

Lavender Tea: to make Lavender Tea, the purple heads of English Lavender *Lavandula Angustifolia* are steeped in boiling water, left to stand for a few minutes, then strained before serving. Although uncommon, there are some commercial teabag preparations available too. The possible benefits are: improvement of mood: calming nervous tension, improvement of sleep patterns, soothe menstrual cramps and improved skin health: anti-bacterial and anti-inflammatory properties for minor skin wounds and skin diseases, e.g. psoriasis.



Special Caution: if you have Heart Disease or take heart drugs for other reasons you should not consume Lavender Tea; it may increase your heart rate.
