Max: "I don't know. Doing work and ... being kind. Miss Pickering. I only got one teacher, not Miss Bubb. We been reading stories and writing." In response to "Is school better than kindergarten?" Max said: "Kinder better, you have fun; have to learn things at school."



Charlize:

"The teachers are teaching me.
Miss Pickering. Umm, one of my
friends helps me when I get hurt.
Some other people get hurt and they
get help, too. We been sharing in a
circle." In answer to: "What have you
been doing today?", Charlize looked
over and replied, "They put that
thing in the circle."

Eliza: "I don't know. Miss Pickering". Eliza showed me a photo-board with students 'present' and 'absent' and proceeded to name most of them. She went back to it a few times to show me again and offer more information. Then: "Can I go back now?" Clearly, Eliza did not want to stay any longer; it was a much better option to rejoin the group to take part in all the exciting class activities.





Black Tea: there are very many varieties of Black Tea; they offer several health benefits due to their rich antioxidant content. flavonoids, caffeine and L-theanine.
