First and foremost, a massive thank you to the Anakie community. The support we've received so far this season has been overwhelming—from kind words in passing and online to the generous donations of food and drinks brought to the station. We are truly grateful.



While we've made it through January, the season is far from over. We have already been kept busy with several calls so far this year, including the recent fire on Geelong-Ballan Rd.

To help us keep everyone safe, please remain vigilant:

- Check the Rating: Make it a daily habit to check the Fire Danger Rating for the Central District. You can find this on the CFA website, the Vic Emergency app, or on the roadside signs as you drive through the area.
- The **Vic Emergency App**: Ensure you have the app installed with a "Watch Zone" set for Anakie to receive instant alerts.
- Have a Plan: Don't wait until you see smoke to decide what to do. Discuss your bushfire survival plan with your household so everyone knows exactly when to leave and where to go.
- Leave Early: On Extreme or Catastrophic days, the safest option is always to leave bushfire risk areas early in the morning.

Return Visit of Kawabe Shihan

We are pleased to announce the return visit of **Kawabe Shihan from Osaka Japan**, being his third visit to Anakie since the opening of the Daito Aiki Jujutsu Dojo in Anakie October 2018. The Dojo, located at 2310 Ballan Road Anakie is led by Leigh Dicker (Head of School for Australia).

Daito Ryu Aiki Jujutsu traces its roots back to the 11th Century in Japan. The core of Daitō-ryū Aiki Jujutsu lies in using timing, subtle body alignment, and precise control of an opponent's balance and intent, rather than strength to neutralise attacks, this "aiki" methods focus on blending with an opponent's movement with minimal force.

Daito Ryu Aiki Jujutsu has Dojos around the world, Japan, Finland, France, USA, and Australia. Leigh Dicker has been Head of School in Australia since Dec 2000 with Dojos in Anakie, Geelong, Ballarat, Gold Coast, Hervey Bay.

Dicker Sensei is 6th Dan Black and recently awarded in Nov 2024 the level of "Kyoju Dairi". A certified level to designate a high level of understanding of the Daitō-ryū aiki-jūjutsu system. All are most welcome to take this opportunity to witness and experience for yourself.
