Spring is bringing us warmer weather! Now is the perfect time to start thinking about getting your property ready for fire

Here are a few ideas for preparing your property for the coming bushfire season:

#### **Clear Gutters and Roofs:**

Remove leaves, twigs and other flammable debris.

Clear a Defendable Space: Clear a 20 metre zone around your house of flammable materials and keep grass mowed (under 10cm to minimise fire risk).

**Prune and Trim Trees:** Trim overhanging branches and prune branches to a height of at least 2 metres.

#### **Maintain Fences and Decks:**

Keep these areas free of flammable materials.

Hibiscus Tea: 'hibiscus sabariffa' is made from the calyces of roselle flowers of the plant.

Hibiscus tea is popular in the Americas, Asia and Africa. It has many health benefits: lowering blood pressure and cholesterol levels, managing weight, excellent for kidney and liver function, anti-inflammatory and contains vitamin C, beta carotene and anti-oxidants. Hibiscus tea is brewed in hot water but is also delicious served cold or iced.

# Ella's Page



This month at the Anakie Community House, we are helping Anakie residents complete their Power Saving Bonus applications. If you were unable to attend on the day and want a hand, please contact my office.

Following this, I thought it might be helpful to provide residents with a brief overview of some other cost of living supports.

### **Free Public Transport**

From January 1 2026 the State Labor Government is making public transport free for everyone under 18, everywhere in Victoria.

And, public transport will also be free on weekends for seniors.

### **Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund**

We're increasing financial support for eligible families to participate in camps, sports and excursions at schools next year. The annual payment

will increase from \$154 for primary students and \$256 for secondary students to \$400 per student.

#### **Active Kids Vouchers**

There is also \$15 million for Get Active Kids vouchers, delivering more than 65,000 extra vouchers, helping even more families with the costs of kids' sport. These vouchers can pay for uniforms, footy boots, and club fees.






